



are understood, loved, and cherished. Spread this message to your family and friends... and they will appreciate that you know the MEANING of Christmas. My very best to you and those you love.





With the holiday season upon us, few things are as cozy as baking up some sweet treats to share with loved ones. Whether it's an office party, Christmas potluck, or a simple family get together, these indulgent Pecan Turtle Bars are hard to refuse. Diane Mouradian of Lodge #65 was kind enough to share her recipe for all to enjoy.

PECAN TURTLE BARS (20)

• 2. c. unsifted all-purpose flour

Lodge #052 - Geraldine Robb, Evansville, IN

- 3/4 c. (1 1/2 sticks) butter or margarine, softened
- 1 ½ c. milk chocolate chips or grated milk chocolate
- 1 ½ c. firmly packed brown sugar
- 1 c. pecan halves

Preheat oven to 350°. In a large bowl of electric mixer at medium speed, combine flour, 1 cup brown sugar, and 1 stick butter, scraping sides of bowl often, until consistency of fine corn meal, about 2 minutes. Pat firmly into a 13 x 9 x 2 baking pan; sprinkle with pecans. Gently press nuts into dough. Caramel Layer: In a heavy 1-quart saucepan, combine remaining butter and brown sugar. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture comes to a boil. Boil for 1 minute, stirring constantly. Pour over pecans and dough. Bake until caramel layer is bubbly, and crust is light golden brown, about 25 minutes. Remove from oven. Immediately sprinkle with chocolate pieces. Allow chocolate to melt slightly, 2 to 3 minutes. For a marbled effect use a paring knife to swirl chocolate, leaving some pecans exposed. Store in airtight container in cool places.
